## 8. Reports on Continuing Activity

8.1 Planting of Barberry bushes within the Crudwell area – to be continued next year should be scheme become viable. The organisers have requested a letter of support from Crudwell Parish Council. *Clerk to draft.* 

8.2 Parish Steward – Councillor Wilson has been in contact with Highways Dept who have advised we must submit jobs for approval before they will be actioned. Next visit 7<sup>th</sup> November 2016. 8.3 Damaged electrical cabinet/area PO Green. This is still being progressed, Cllr Wilson will ask local builders from Crudwell and Cllr Gilchrest also has a contact he can ask. It was agreed that the Parish Council is looking for a quote in the region of £500. Cllr Stanford will paint the socket protector in some brightly coloured paint to draw attention to the area.
